WATER...WATER..

WATER HARVESTING SCHEME

In 2006 Ratby Parish Council provided enough ground for 8 half size allotment plots. The mains water supply was 150 yards away and it would have cost £3000 + to install a tap on the allotment: not cost effective.

Our secretary suggested we harvest the water from the adjacent building. Permission was


sought and readily given. We applied to ${\it eok}$

Central Networks for a grant to do this work, and the system was put in place. Water comes from the roof via a diverter into the interconnected storage tanks, and can then be pumped to the other end of the plot.

The remainder of the grant award will be used to create 4 deep raised beds on a slabbed area for wheel chair users. The area for this has been designated. Slabs no longer needed in upgraded pathways were donated by the Parish Church.

WATER AID RATBY METHODIST CHURCH

Ratby Methodist Church has always been a caring church that reaches out to those in need in the local community. It is also aware of the needs of the wider world in which we live, supporting charities further afield.

For the Methodist year (Sept 2007 to Aug 2008) a specific charity has been chosen – WaterAid.

So many millions of people are deprived of this life-sustaining essential. We turn on a tap to receive fresh drinking water while others have to walk 5 miles or more to the nearest water source. In many countries children are responsible for drawing and carrying the family's water.

There is so much that could be written about these situations but space does not allow for that. However, one heart-rending fact is that 5,000 children die every day from diarrhoea caused by poor sanitation and unsafe water.

Members and friends of the Methodist Church have been collecting their pennies throughout Lent to add to their Advent appeal. Their target for the year is £750 – enough to construct a hand-dug well and fit a hand pump, providing water for up to 200 people.


Annual Pond Dipping 7 pm August 6th.






'DOWN TO EARTH' in the Church

Sunday March 30th
