



REMEMBERING

RATBY SERVICE MEN KILLED IN WORLD WAR II

Mrs Kathleen Green of Groby has kindly sent in these records of War Cemetery burials. They will be of general interest and of particular poignancy for any remaining relatives in the village. Her husband recalls that news of four of the group arrived on the same day, a sad time in Ratby.

Mrs Green says that the records were made by Mr George Finney of Ratby, who did extensive research. The information is from the War Graves Commission, 24/10/1984



VILLAGE SOCIETY NOTES.

At our August meeting we were treated to a talk on "The Myths of Chemicals" by our Chairman, Jack Haywood. Jack's background as a research chemist in the plastics and paper industries was evident in the depth of his knowledge. He introduced the subject with a history of chemistry and famous chemists, making the point that chemists are not pharmacists and should not be asked for advice on treating colds etc.!

Noteworthy chemists included Paracelsus who, in the 16th century, was the cause of the confusion between chemists and pharmacists as he was proficient in both fields. There was also Dalton who worked with atoms and Crick and Watson who analysed DNA (which we all know stands for deoxyribonucleic acid, don't we?). Mendeleev was responsible for the Table of Elements, each one given a number and a symbol, which gave rise to those horrendous formulae beloved of Chemistry teachers.

We were comforted to know that they had some use however, as they were explained in terms of weed killer, soap, salt and toothpaste. Even the chemistry involved in rubbing a nettle sting with a dock leaf became clear.

At the end of a most interesting and enlightening evening we were only glad that there wasn't a test on what we had learned!


