Thanks to the demand for their Ratby 2000 CD ROM, the Ratby Millennium Photographic Project was able to purchase and plant eight Sorbus Aucuparia Fastigiata Trees. These are specie of native rowan, or mountain ash. With the blessing of the Parish Council they were planted on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2003 at Jubilee Green, Taverner Drive.

The trees will grow up flame-shaped, and bear orange-red berries in the autumn, forming a pleasant visual entrance to the village from Kirby Muxloe.

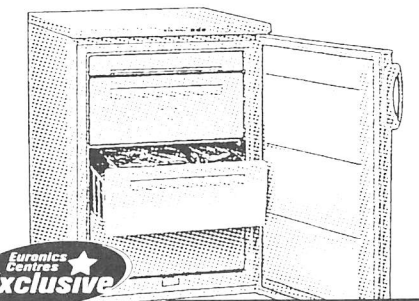

## COMMUNITY ORCHARD GROUP WASSAIL

The Railway Inn was once again the meeting  
point for the 'new tradition' of Wassailing the  
apple trees.

A large group of members gathered here for the  
first Wassail song and warming drink before  
processing in traditional style, playing music,  
and banging drums or saucepan lids, to the  
orchard.

Here the time-honoured rituals were again  
performed. Cider was poured on the ground  
around the selected trees, and the 'toast' to the  
trees was performed. The women hung toast in  
the branches, to bring luck and attract beneficial  
birds. The men let off party poppers to represent  
the original shotgun firing which was used to  
scare evil spirits.

Then the wassail bowl with mulled cider was  
passed around, everyone taking a sip. The  
wassail ended with chestnuts and baked potatoes  
around the 'fire in a wheelbarrow.'

## RECIPE OPEN APPLE TART

### Ingredients

Short crust Pastry:

2 oz (55g) butter or margarine

8 oz (225g) plain flour

2 oz (55g) Lard

pinch of salt

Cold water to mix

9" Pie plate

### Filling

1lb (450g) chopped cooking apples

2 oz (55g) butter

1 egg

4 oz (110g) sugar

1 lemon

### Method

1. Make pastry and line pie plate with it.
2. Melt butter, stir in beaten egg, sugar, apple pieces, grated rind and juice of lemon.
3. Pour the mixed filling into the lined pie plate.
4. Bake in middle of pre-heated oven, temperature 190C/375F/GAS 5 for 35 - 40 minutes.

The ingredients would also make two x 6" /15cm tarts. Foil plates can be used.
