### RATBY CUBS GOING GREEN

1<sup>st</sup> Ratby Cub troop have been working towards their Conservation Badge. Cub Leader, Akela Abbey Murby contacted John Cawrey to ask whether there was anything they could be involved in.

So on a chilly evening in March around twenty cubs gathered along the newest village road, Bancroft Way, to plant native trees and hedgerow alongside the fence. There were some standard trees to plant for impact, Field Maple and Holly, and plenty of hedgerow whips. This will be a mixed hedgerow of native plants; Common Hawthorn, Crab Apple, Dogwood and Purging Buckthorn. John Cawrey and the firm's Landscape Contractor Greg Thurlow were there to assist the cub leaders. Getting the holes dug in the hard, clay soil was tough work, but the children set to with enthusiasm.

Fundraising for the past year is on target with the Christmas Fair, a Jumble Sale and a spot at the recent Yard Sales all doing really well.



# RATBY CO-OPERATIVE BAND Impressive Showing for Ratby Band at Blackpool Contest

The Ratby Co-operative Brass Band recently claimed an impressive result during the Spring Festival Contest at Blackpool on 9<sup>th</sup> May. The band finished 5<sup>th</sup> out of 21 competing bands in the Senior Cup section of the contest after being drawn to play last. They performed Eric Ball's masterpiece "Festival Music" to a large audience in Blackpool's Winter Gardens, delivering a performance almost good enough to qualify for the Grand Shield contest next year, as four bands are invited from the Senior Cup contest.

Michael Fowles, the Ratby Co-operative Brass Band's Musical Director, said: "The band gave a very musical performance of an incredibly difficult set work. We received very positive feedback from various people who heard us play. Narrowly missing out on qualification for the prestigious Grand Shield contest again shows great consistency. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in recent years the band has come 5<sup>th</sup> so we are knocking on that door very strongly."

The result from the Spring Festival is the lates in a string of strong performances from the Ratby Co-operative Brass Band, as they also claimed 5<sup>th</sup> place at the Midlands Regional Brass Band Championships in March, being tipped by many in the audience and the banding Press for a higher finish.

Ratby is an ideal village to live in, with countryside all round and some lovely walks. What a pity then that one of our best country lanes is being spoilt by fly tipping - and not just the usual eyesore of unwanted and illegally tipped household rubbish, but very much unwanted remains of drug production. A walk along Burroughs Road towards the ford over the past few months has seen the dumping of large root balls pulled from pots, with the remains of stalks showing, and the odd leaf, easily identified as Marijuana. Six to eight of these spent plants have been left in gateways along the road on three occasions this year, and a glance over nearby fences reveals others that have clearly been there

The police have been informed on at least three occasions, but there is little they can do without visual sighting of the vehicle being used. CCTV can be an unwanted intrusion into perfectly respectable lives - but may be the only way to stop what is clearly a thriving business in the production of illegal and dangerous drugs.
